Bob Ahlberg led a discussion on the 2005 amendment; 50% or more open space on fences. It appears the consensus of the commission is to allow solid fences in limited circumstances. No changes in front yard language. Side yard; open fence to 6 ft, sold to 4 ft. Rear of house 6 ft solid or open fence. On a corner lot, solid fence to be located a minimum distance from the street lot line equivalent 50% of the minimum required side yard.

One speaker, Riley Kotyza a Deep Path resident asked about fence heights on her property.

Commissioner Belcore made a motion seconded by Commissioner Arnos to close the public hearing. All were in favor.

Commissioner Gerhardt made a motion seconded by Commissioner Naatz to recommend the changes to the fence ordinance to the Village Board. All were in favor.

Commissioner Belcore motion seconded by Commissioner Gerhardt to adjourn at 7:51 pm. Chairperson Cavanaugh declared the motion passed on a unanimous voice vote.
