# Engineering - Jacob Wellbank, Robinson Engineering - Present

• Stonewater – large mass earthwork project ongoing and seeing single family home permits for Phases 3 & 4

#### Sewer and Water - Jacob Wellbank, Robinson Engineering - Present

- Stonewater operating normally, began submitting reports to IEPA
- **Meadows of West Bay** Village President Dycus asked about the iron issue in MOWB; Jacob informed the Board will check in to the problem

- Tax Cap it will be at 5% again this year
- Ordinance will bring at next meeting, consumption of alcohol will be taken out of Business Regulations and move to General Offenses in the codification
- Appropriation Ordinance filed with the County Clerk along with the Certification of Revenue Estimate
