Public Comment:

- Ed Peters, Sunrise Ridge HOA President here to inform the Village will be asking to permit non-highway vehicles; in review of fall leaf pick up hop to have spring pick up and advance notification; Public Works Director Bissell informed the Board that will have robo call 10 days in advance; Trustee Naatz informed the Board that robo calls may not be working for people who have dropped landlines; maybe an email campaign would be more effective.
- **Dick Hilton, Nippersink Watershed Association –** Last night the County Board approved the demolition of the house across from the old Village Hall at the County's expense; will cut back and rip rap the banks.

Presentation by ComEd

Suzanna Strangmeier, External Affairs Manager and Steve Doyan, Reliability Engineer for ComEd, informed the board that ComEd services over 4,000 residents of Wonder Lake. The Energy Infrastructure Modernization Act has allowed Com Ed to plan and build strength into Wonder Lake's electricity infrastructure and improve reliability:

- East Side Downtown area in 2018 to help about 500 customer with spacer cable to help reduce outages if a
 tree falls, creating backup or redundancies on the equipment in Wonder Lake that allows switching for faster
 restoration or more paths to get the power flowing
- West Side will receive help for about 300 customers in 2019 starting in May.

Trustees asked about energy efficiency for schools, green initiatives and if possible to change Village street lights (ComEd rental fixtures) to LED lights.
