Presentation by Andy Teegan, NRB Land, LLC

NRB Attorney informed the Board that the Amended and Restated Annexation Agreement was reviewed by the Village Engineer, Village Planner and the Village Attorney. Andy Teegan, NRB Land, submitted MPD Plan revisions to the Village Planning and Zoning Commission and the revisions were approved last night. The changes are to get more buildable land and larger lots so took 11 acres of open space and redistributed (461 acres of open space down to 450 acres); sell out time change from 12-13 years to 25 years; 11.3 multi-purpose trails and 140 acres open water. Annexation Agreement changes - phased approach to sewer and water; IEPA Loan Program & Collateral behind it (2 years of payment, collateral letter); Route 120 turn lanes in Phase 1 and Traffic Signal in Phase 2; School Provisions are complete now and Silt Depository wording change. Thatcher Meadows will be ready to go in fall 2020. Trustees discussed how the 362 homes on the eastside of Wonder Lake will get water in Phase 1; the surface water from the development will go out Harrison but the waste water will go out on the eastside (Dutch Creek); that the water rate increase is only needed for the IEPA to complete the loan package but will not be enacted on at this time. Village President Topf asked if any public comment. There was no public comment.
