- **Drainage Swale –** it is in, culvert at road is at the same level as the lake so may need to move pipe up; working with township so may only need to buy new pipe
- Elm Street negotiated to resurface; materials will cost \$50,000 to \$60,000, trees will need to be cut back
- **Road Program** received letter that Indian Trail residents and the County are not interested in the road program but if the Village pays the County will pave Wildwood & Salem; the roads are not the Village responsibility
- **Wooded Shores** Oakwood has 10 or 11 homes on a 2" main; held money back to resurface the road; waiting for numbers from Diehmer for directional bore to replace with 6" main.
- **Church Sign –** Reverend Long was cited; court case will be in May; Village Attorney Curran has received letters from the Reverend's Attorney
- Motor Fuel Tax approximately \$100,000 a year
- Well House Repairs most are done
- IT fees due for email and hours; \$1,500 for email and 100 hours
- Robinson Contract Village Attorney Curran reviewed the contract and made some corrections
- Retirement Village Administrator Weir announced his retirement on June 1st
